Blix, giving a 60-day progress report on Iraq's compliance with U.N. resolution 1441, said Iraq has failed to account for large quantities of VX poison gas and anthrax it claims to have destroyed. He said there is "strong evidence" that Iraq maintained quantities of anthrax after it claimed to have destroyed its stocks. U.N. resolution 1441 orders Baghdad to disclose all weapons of mass destruction and related materials.

Blix said the discovery of empty rocket artillery shells capable of carrying chemical weapons shows "that Iraq needs to make more effort to ensure that its declaration is currently accurate."
